<input type="checkbox"/> Organic Farm (partial)	Part of the operation is certified organic.
<input type="checkbox"/> Organic Transition	Operation transitioning to organic production or using organic particles (but not certified organic)
<input type="checkbox"/> Custom Operator	Operator paid to perform farm operations for owner
<input type="checkbox"/> Expansion Hogs	A 25% or greater increase in the size of hog operation.
<input type="checkbox"/> Contraction Hogs	A 25% or greater decrease in the size of hog operation.
<input type="checkbox"/> Expansion Sheep	A 25% or greater increase in the size of sheep operation.
<input type="checkbox"/> Contraction Sheep	A 25% or greater decrease in the size of sheep operation.
<input type="checkbox"/> Beginning Farmer	Producer operating 10 years or less.
<input type="checkbox"/> Limited Resource/Socially Disadvantaged Producer	A historically underserved producer including Minority (Native American, Asian, African American, or Hispanic), Women, and Limited resource producers.

<input type="checkbox"/> Climate Smart Project (participant)	Producer participating in climate smart projects, that reduce greenhouse gas emission or sequester carbon.
<input type="checkbox"/> Environmental & Structural Water Quality Controls	Using management strategies to reduce nutrient loss from both surface and subsurface water flows. Ex: grassed waterways, terraces, buffer strips, etc.
